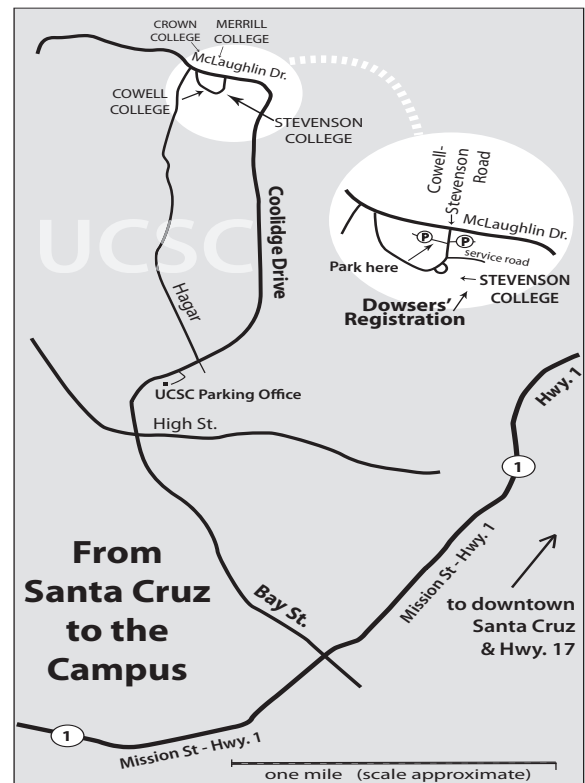
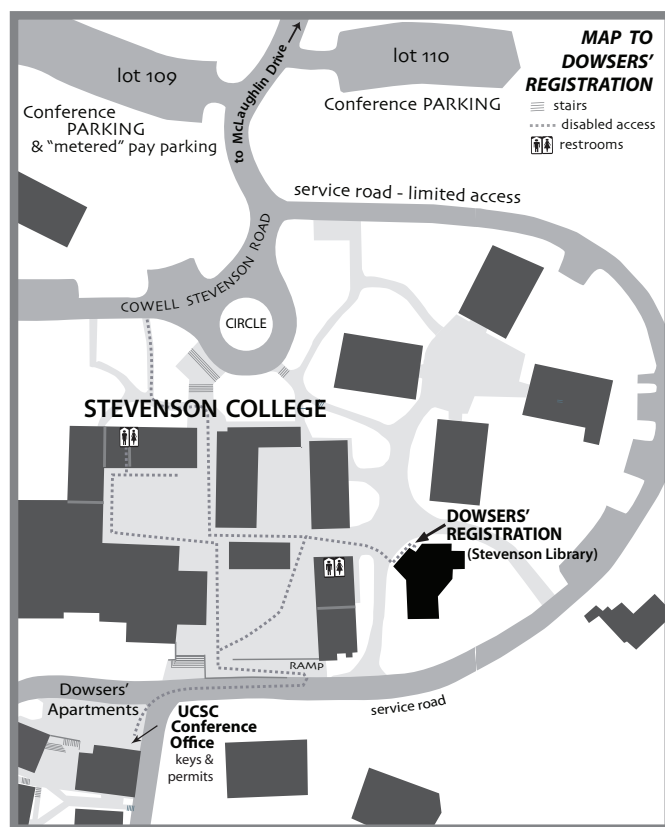


Coming to the West Coast Dowsing Conference — KEEP this information!

PLEASE NOTE: We are at a NEW CAMPUS SITE this year.

DIRECTIONS:

- From Route 17, take Route 1 north (Mission St.) to Bay St. and turn **RIGHT**....
- From Route 1 south (Mission St.), turn **LEFT** on Bay...
- **Take Bay St. up** to the campus entrance at High St.
- Go straight across onto **Coolidge**, proceed 1.4 miles. Shortly after the road enters a wooded area, it turns left and becomes **McLaughlin Drive**.
- Take the first **LEFT** off McLaughlin onto **Cowell-Stevenson Rd.**
- Parking is on the right immediately after turning. The entrance to Stevenson College is just up the road at the Stevenson College Circle (with redwood trees). Follow signs to Dowsers' Registration.



ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS – REGISTRATION and PARKING

- Please allow at least an hour to register and get your parking permit.
- Park at a pay stall until you have obtained your parking permit. There is a pay station and pay stalls in lot 109, the first right turn off Cowell-Stevenson Road. As soon as you have your permit, move your car to one of the two CONFERENCE PARKING lots (109 and 110, across from 109.) There is a remote lot at Merrill College, further up McLaughlin Drive.
- OFFICE HOURS – The Dowsers' Registration office is open Thurs., **June 28th from 2 to 8 p.m.** and **June 29th from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m.** From **June 30th through July 2nd**, the office will be open from **8 a.m. to 7 p.m. except during meals.**

The office will be open on Tues., **July 3rd from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.**, which is check-out time for on-campus lodging unless other arrangements have been made.

ARRIVALS AT OTHER TIMES OF DAY —

- You need to park in a pay stall in the lot and pay at the pay station. Leave your luggage and follow the signs to Dowsers' Registration.
- Register or check in and get your name ribbon.
- Get your parking permit and room keys at the UCSC Conference office. (If you are staying on campus, the parking fee is included.) If you are commuting, you must pay for a parking permit that covers the days you are there.

EVENING ARRIVALS: Please try to arrive before 7:30 p.m. Before 8 p.m., go to the UCSC Conference Office (see map above). If you must arrive after 8 p.m., **call well beforehand** for instructions: 978-496-8599.

From 8 p.m. to 2 a.m., the campus CSO (831-459-2100) can let you into your room, but cannot provide keys.

IMPORTANT: If you arrive after 2 a.m., we will be unable to house you that night, and you will have to seek your own accommodations in town.

PARKING:

- Display your permit in your car and move it to a lot with a “CONFERENCE PERMITS” sign (circled on the photo).
- Park only in lots with a small “CONFERENCE PERMITS” square on the sign. Rules are strictly enforced. A parking permit is required everywhere on campus. The Conference cannot be responsible for parking tickets.

COMMUTER attendees will need a parking permit every day – get one when you check in. The cost is \$9 per day.



SPECIAL PARKING PERMITS: RVs / CAMPERS – Vehicles longer than a standard automobile will require an additional permit from the campus police. These may not be used as lodging on campus. The police may verify that RVs are not being used as lodging. • For permit information, call 831-459-1097.

BAGGAGE: If you need help with your baggage, come to Dowsers’ Registration for assistance.

COMING BY AIR: San Francisco airport (SFO) is 70 miles from Santa Cruz. Please allow at least 3 hours from your expected arrival time. Driving time is 1 to 2 hours, depending on traffic. From SJC, (San Jose) driving time is 45 minutes to an hour or more.

COMING BY BUS: Greyhound’s main number is 800-231-2222. In Santa Cruz, call Greyhound at 831-423-1800.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION: Santa Cruz Metro is a good local transit system. The bus to downtown Santa Cruz runs frequently. Call 831-425-8600 for information on travel to Stevenson College.

SCHOOL ATTENDEES: Please allow about an hour to park and register for School. Bring a hat and sunscreen, as some of the schools and presentations are outdoors. Wear your name ribbon. Your School registration also entitles you to the evening’s introduction of speakers and their brief presentation descriptions, as well as the Hospitality Room, which follows evening events.

CLIMATE AND CLOTHING: Daytime temperatures are usually 70° to 80° F after the morning fog burns off, and nights are in the 50°s-60°s. Please bring things warm enough to be comfortable! Include a warm sweater or jacket, comfortable shoes, and you may want your slippers. Rain is unusual, but occasionally comes to greet us, even in July.

SMOKING: There is **NO SMOKING anywhere** on campus. **DOGS:** Sorry, no dogs are allowed on campus.

SUSTAINABILITY: Please bring your own **refillable water bottle** – UCSC encourages waste reduction.
